Beyond hospital walls, Starlight Canada's wish fulfillment programs serve 2,000 families annually, with 100% of participants reporting stronger family bonds and 92% of children showing improved mental health after their experiences.

Besides providing much needed support to children and their families across Canada, Starlight Canada also participates in and hosts various fundraising events throughout the Montreal area, including the Drive For Smiles at ICAR Mirabel on May 30-31, the Starlight Open Golf Tournament at The Royal Montreal Golf Club on August 11, and the Tea & Tiaras event at Jaguar Land Rover West Island on September 28, 2025.

This collaboration marks an important initiative for Future Electronics' Build Hope Together foundation, which focuses on creating positive social impact in communities where the company operates.
